ARTICLE III ---- MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

(d) HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

The Honorary Membership Committee may recommend and the Board of Directors may approve a lifetime Honorary Membership for any person that they wish to recognize for outstanding achievement or service in the labor field. This membership is honorary only, and does not entitle the holder to any of the rights, privileges, or obligations of any other type of membership. These members will not be assigned to or be able to join any chapter.
