**Whereas** – The approval for a member to join a new chapter should be sent to the new chapter instead of the old chapter.

**Therefore, be it resolved** - that Article V Section 2 letter (b) should include the underlined language.

**New Language**

**ARTICLE V ---- CHAPTERS**

**Section 2. JURISDICTION**

- (a) Insofar as is practicable, the jurisdiction of a regular chapter shall conform to department, board, commission, institution and agency organization of the state, private sector employer, or combination thereof, and any political subdivision, or combination thereof, and its accessibility for active participation.
- (b) A member may request the Association to join a chapter outside his/her assigned jurisdiction, and the Association shall forward that request to the chapter they wish to join for approval.
- (c) No member may transfer to any chapter unless he/she is in good standing.
