Ralph Mecheau gave the political education committee report. The committee has finished interviews for Democratic candidates for CD-1 seat. 1 Republican interview is upcoming. The recommendation to endorse Maggie Goodlander was unanimous in the CD-2 Democratic primary. The Political Education Committee voted 11-5 against endorsing Victor Orlando in the CD-2 Republican primary.

Ralph Mecheau made a motion to endorse Maggie Goodlander in the CD-2 Democratic Primary, and the motion was duly seconded. The motion passed.

Cullen Tiernan and Bob Blaisdell gave the political update. The Faster Labor Contracts act passed the US House, with some Republicans supporting. Some younger conservatives are supporting labor based on family values and affordability. The NH State House session is over, we played successful defense this session. The first fiscal year for NH has revenues above plan.

Mary Fields moved to accept reports into the record, and the motion was duly seconded. The motion passed.

Melissa Delorey took a moment of personal privilege to thank Justin for his time with us.
